HOG Meeting Minutes 4/15/18

The meeting came to order at 10:00 am with the Pledge of Allegiance.

New Members and Guests – We welcomed five new members and one guest this month!

Health and Welfare – Nothing new, all seems well!

HOG Manager – Brian Sedlack commented that it was great to see new faces! He talked about the Freedom of Expression event that occurred that Thursday evening. At the request of John Kresse, they held a headlight alignment demo and a product seminar.

Last month there was a clothing question and Brian wants us to know that the apparel department can order clothes at any time. If we want Syracuse HOG stuff, they will have an order form and 2018 catalogs.

He talked about Ride 365. Please come to the dealership to get registered and give your mileage for the season. April 28th is the bike blessing.

April is National Check your Helmet month. There is an email with 15% off any helmets in stock. DOT recommends to replace helmets every 3-5 years or if you drop it. John Kresse suggested to dissemble your helmet so it can't be reused.

Dealership – Bruno expanded on Brian's talk and reminded us that PHD is invested in HOG as much as HOG is invested in PHD. They want to increase our relationship.

Treasurer's Report – Joanne Piston told us that there was very little activity this month and that we have about \$2000 in the bank.

Membership – Mike Piston reminded us to sign in at meetings. We have 70 members for the year so far. We have membership forms at PHD next to the service desk. He can also email an electronic copy if anyone needs it.

Head Road Captain/Safety – John Kresse is going to look into getting HOG signs for parades. He also put the map creation on Facebook and is going to connect it to the PHD gpx file (a Garmin route). His article this month is about headlights.

Activities – Anne Marie Camardella had to cancel the bowling because of lack of interest. If you are able to help with the Bike Blessing please let her know.

Ladies of Harley – International Female Ride Day is May 5th. Terry Lynn is going to lead a ride that day but the men are also welcome. Please continue to remember our vets with donations. They are in need of new sweatshirts, sweatpants, games, crafts and books, as well as sundries.

Community Service – TELOC is Saturday, April 21st from 8-11pm. Come between 7-7:30 for food and a 15 minute training. We have volunteers, but can always use more! Please continue to bring in canned goods...we have a bin in the conference room for them.

Historian – Jim Lanfair wasn't at the meeting.

Webmaster – As of May 1st, there will be a new password for the website. It will be emailed by Jason. The Google calendar is done with 90 rides and events scheduled! Jason told us that a lot of the Tuesday and Thursday rides are still TBA – please reach out to Kevin, John or Jason to update the calendar. He will send out a blast if there are changes to the calendar. There are also links to food asked that we make sure to skim through entire emails from HOG because sometimes attachments from the same day are put together (not on purpose.)

Our Facebook site is now public so PHD can share our posts. We have admins that approve posts. You are allowed to post anything motorcycle related as long as you're not trying to sell something.

Our website is still private. If you need the password to the website, ask Kevin. There is also a google calendar on the website with everything

listed to mix with your own personal calendar. He has also included links to food and destinations for the rides on the calendar!

Assistant Director – Steve is going to lead a ride to Maine for the Iron Adventure this summer. He sent around a signup sheet and has already reserved a few rooms if you are interested. He also sent around a signup sheet for a museum visit in Wisconsin (400 mile ride). Steve talked about his newsletter article.

Director – Kevin told us that the bylaws were done in 1990/1991 so we are updating them. Officers will be looking through a rough draft to take out irrelevant information and change the date. We have a new welcome packet for new members. We will start having the meeting minutes put out within a week of the meeting so the information is still current (sorry about this month!).

We had a successful meet and greet at the Blarney Stone. We are trying to make our meet and greets more standardized with the same day and time each week to help us remember.

Next month's meeting is cancelled but PHD is still open at 11.

New Business – John Snyder reminded the group that our rides are closed but we will accept guests (including PHD employees). They can sign a waiver and don't need to ride a Harley.

The rules for HOG insurance states that if someone drinks alcohol on a ride, that event ends their ride with the group. The new rule through National states that the ride can be the whole trip (not just to the destination) unless they drink alcohol, then they are on their own.

Dave Ferguson announced that he will pick up flags for the Watchfire at PHD.
